# Consequences

# Procedures for filling out Conduct Cuts

- Page 7 – Title Conduct Cuts
- Step 1 – You will receive a warning for the behavior that is distracting the learning environment
- Step 2 – You receive the conduct cut and walk silently to the log and fill out your form.
- Step 3 – Walk back to your seat quietly
- Tips – If you do not believe you did what I accused you of, you must wait until a break in class or the end of class to ask me about it.
- If you make a scene walking to, filling out the log, or walking back to your seat it will be an automatic call home and second conduct cut.
