RULE OF LAW

 Definition - The idea that all people must follow a law that is fairly applied and enforced

REPUBLIC

• Definition – a form of government in which the people vote and elect their representatives

REPRESENTATIVE GOVERNMENT

 Definition - a type of government by chosen representatives, usually elected from among a large group

SEPARATION OF POWER

 Definition - the separation of power in separate branches of the government

• Example - the executive, legislative, and judicial powers of a government.

PERSECUTE

 Definition - to pursue with harassing or oppressive treatment, especially because of religious or political beliefs

CITIZEN

- Definition a native or naturalized member of a state or nation who owes allegiance to its government and is entitled to its protection
- Citizenship varied greatly. The full citizen could vote, marry freeborn persons, and practice commerce. Some citizens were not allowed to vote or hold public office, but maintained the other rights. A third type of citizen could vote and proactive commerce, but could not hold office or marry freeborn women.

MONARCHY

System of government in which one person holds the power

BALANCE OF POWERS

 The Roman system was based on a balance of interest. The American Founding Fathers were heavily influenced by the Romans but the United States' system of checks and balances is based on a balance of powers and functions.

CIVIC DUTY

Definition - the responsibilities of a citizen
