RULE OF LAW

- Definition - The idea that all people must follow a law that is fairly applied and enforced



REPUBLIC

- Definition – a form of government in which the people vote and elect their representatives

REPRESENTATIVE GOVERNMENT

- Definition - a type of government by chosen representatives, usually elected from among a large group

SEPARATION OF POWER

- Definition - the separation of power in separate branches of the government
- Example - the executive, legislative, and judicial powers of a government.

PERSECUTE

- Definition - to pursue with harassing or oppressive treatment, especially because of religious or political beliefs

CITIZEN

- Definition - a native or naturalized member of a state or nation who owes allegiance to its government and is entitled to its protection
- Citizenship varied greatly. The full citizen could vote, marry freeborn persons, and practice commerce. Some citizens were not allowed to vote or hold public office, but maintained the other rights. A third type of citizen could vote and practice commerce, but could not hold office or marry freeborn women.



MONARCHY

- System of government in which one person holds the power

BALANCE OF POWERS

- The Roman system was based on a balance of interest. The American Founding Fathers were heavily influenced by the Romans but the United States' system of checks and balances is based on a balance of powers and functions.



CIVIC DUTY

- Definition - the responsibilities of a citizen
